I/We will:

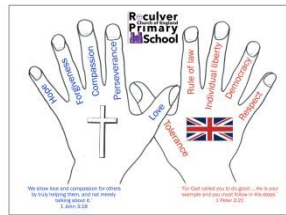
- Ensure that my/our child attends school regularly
