Dear Parents/Carers

In school the children will be learning about 'Pudding Pan Island' on Friday 7th October.

What is Pudding Pan Island?

A Roman Cargo ship was bringing Samian pottery to England in 200AD. During a storm one crashed into a submerged Island off the coast of Kent (visible from the Turner gallery). The ship sunk with its cargo on board. In the 1800 it was discovered by the Victorians who mistook them for pudding pots and used them for baking. Their significance has only recently been discovered.

In Year 2 we have decided to walk to the beach as part of our learning in school about Pudding Pan Island.

We will be out for part of the morning only so your child does not need to bring in a packed lunch (unless they usually do) as we will be back at school before lunch time . Uniform is to be worn but sensible shoes would be advisable. Please send in a waterproof jacket just in case!
