Things to try...

- ✚ Writing in sand and soil, using finger, stick, pebble
- ✚ Writing in shaving foam, wallpaper paste (slime) gloop (cornflower and water)
- ✚ Using chinks - designated area (cheap and washable)
- ✚ Filling colouring sheets with handwriting patterns
 - ✚ Tracing letters
 - ✚ Writing on wall paper (back) - cheap/free
- ✚ REMEMBER! Every letter starts and finishes on a 'magic line'
