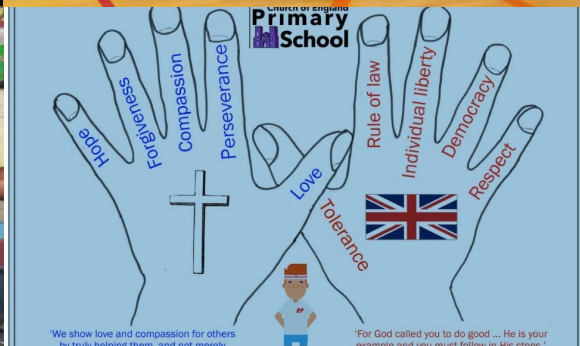

We think...

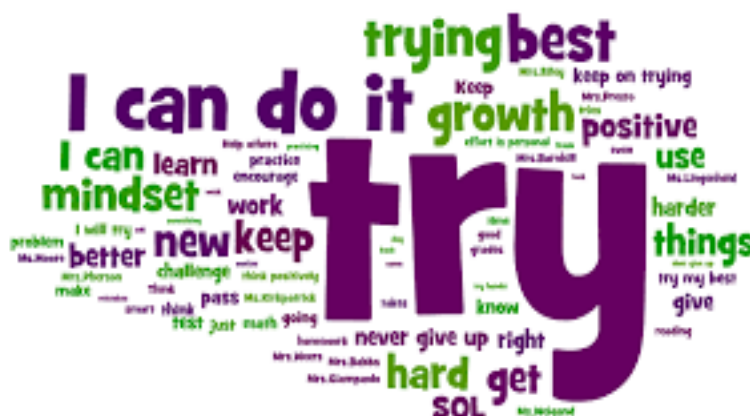
- Mrs Ashley Jones and Mrs Collins are in charge of the school
