

Assessment in RE (Appendix 2)

How we assess RE at Reculver C of E Primary School

Rationale behind new assessment framework

The Diocese has produced a new assessment document that allows key objectives from each unit of work to be assessed accurately. These objectives are taken directly from the Understanding Christianity framework and World Faith plans that form the Kent Agreed Syllabus. Teachers assess every child against each object within the units taught. If children have not met the objective it is recorded as a 1, if they have met it, a 2, and if they have exceeded the objective, a 3.

Teachers record overall levels of pupil attainment on to SIMS at the end of every term and this is analysed at the end of each term by the subject leader.

Levels of progress and attainment are reported to the Head Teacher by the Subject Leader so that any pupils requiring further support are provided with opportunities to enhance their learning.

At the end of every academic year, teachers report levels of progress and attainment to parents.
