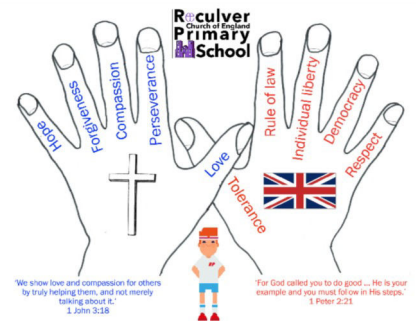

Ruby— Mrs Berry Jacob has been working super hard on his reading this week, both at home and in school. Well done Jacob!

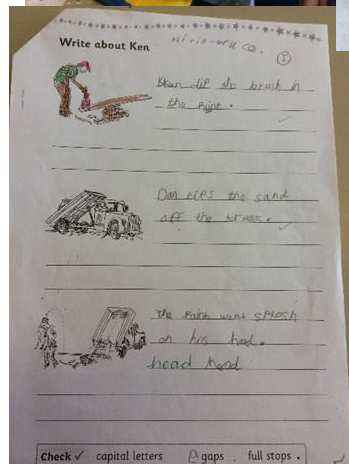
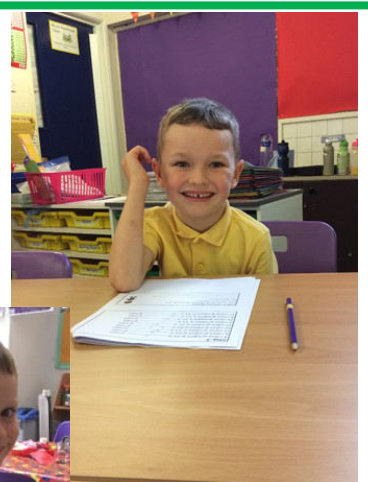
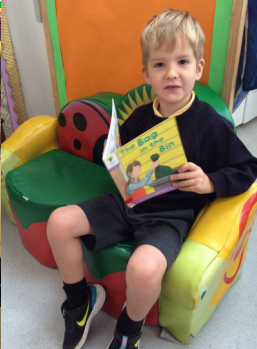
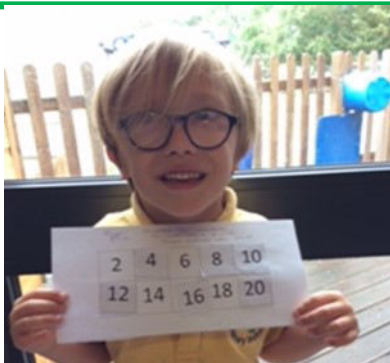
